Discussion: Residents of Mullett Township would like to have the dock at the public beach on Sutherland Street restored so people can dock their boats to go to the Topinabee businesses, letter from Nokia requesting same, also letter from Carl Muscott letter with pictures regarding the enchroachment of township property. a grant for funding to convert the old school house to a public library for Topinabee. Seconded by John Brown. Motion passed

Motion by Karen Morgan to transfer \$200.00 from the General Fund to the Liquor Fund. Seconded by John Brown. Motion passed.

Motion by John Brown to increase the 101-622-930 line item by \$5,000.00 in order to pay for the Gypsy Moth Spraying bill. Seconded by Dennis Dombroski. Motion passed.

Motion to remove Pollyanna Hand and Elizabeth Benson from the Straits Area Credit Union Bank Accounts. Rachel Osborn and Karen Morgan are the Primary Signatures with Teresa Schepperly and Helen Zimmer to be added as Deputies. Motion offered by Dennis Dombroski, seconded by Rachel Osborn, Motion passed.
