MEETING – OCTOBER 5, 2010

The Mullett Township Board of Trustees met at the Mullett Township Hall on October 5, 2010 at 8:00pm. All Board Members were present: Bill Morgan, Rachel Osborn, Karen Morgan, Dennis Dombroski and John Brown.

The meeting was led in the Pledge of Allegiance by Dennis Dombroski.

Open Forum: Marie Hazelman of Presque Isle Electric, Mary O'Hare, Bob English

A discussion was offered by Bob English regarding So. Extension Road and the snow plowing situation.

Alice Mushlock is running for County Commissioner District #4.

John Brown will take care of the docks and will replace the 2 X 12 X 8 foot treated boards on one of the older style docks.

Dennis Dombroski had discussion with Tom O'Hare regarding the beautification of Topinabee.

Motion to approve \$600.00 for Fleis and Vendenbrink to pursue points for the DNR Beach Grant was offered by Karen Morgan and seconded by Dennis Dombroski, Motion passed.

The expense report for the second quarter of the fiscal year was read by Rachel Osborn with a grand total of \$267,169.44 for all funds.

Jim Conboy is asking the township to spend \$182.00 for signs for the bike trail, motion was tabled and he will be offered a chance to come to a board meeting.

Motion to increase road project line item #101-446-933 \$75,000.00 in order to pay for Newton Street was made by John Brown and seconded by Dennis Dombroski. Motion passed.

Motion to approve Patty King and Rachel Osborn to go to Michigan Library Association in Traverse City on November 11, 12 and 13 was made by John Brown and seconded by Dennis Dombroski, Motion passed.

There will be a public hearing on Quail Trail and So. Extension Road at the Road Commission Building in Indian River on October 21, 2010 at 5:30pm.

Allen Traugh wants to remove street light in front of his place and the board does not.

A Resolution to approve boundary line was offered by John Brown pending on signatures of all parties to the Penberton/Miller boundary line adjustments. And supported by Dennis Dombroski. By a roll call vote as follows:
