

MULLETT TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
MEETING, NOVEMBER 4, 2010

The Mullett Township Board of Trustees met at the Mullett Township Hall in Topinabee at 7:45pm. All board members were present: Willard Morgan, Rachel Osborn, Karen Morgan Dennis Dombroski and John Brown.

There was an opening with the Pledge of Allegiance by Dennis Dombroski.

Bill Morgan opened the Public Hearing for the Park and Recreation Five Year Plan from 2011 through 2016. Members of the community who attended were as follows: Paul Chapaton, Tom and Mary O'Hare, David Ogg, Carl Muscot, Mike English, Bob English, Helen Zimmer, Patty King, Teresa Schepperly, James Larson, Kriston Tant, Ken Pritchett and Erin Crawford.

Rick Stout of Fleis and Vandenbrink presented the highlights of the Park and Recreation Plan and pointed out some updates regarding population changes, school changes, addition of Boy Scout Park and a trail project Mullett Township is participating with Burt Township. Tom O'Hare contributed with public comment and his remarks are attached. (2 pages)  
Paul Chapaton thanked the township for the new dock at Woodruff.

John Brown made a motion to close the public hearing which was seconded by Dennis Dombroski.

The minutes of October were read and approved with the following correction, MLA Conference is November 10, 11, 12. John Brown proposed the motion and Dennis Dombroski seconded, Motion passed.

Paul Chapaton wants to know where to go for maintenance on So. Extension Road.

Carl Muscot brought to the attention of the board that the speed signs coming into Topinabee

from the south do not drop the speed to 45 until you reach the Breakers where it used to be dropped at Ranch Road. Bill Morgan to contact MDOT.

Kristen Tant says there will not be a bakery in Topinabee.

TAC will be decorating on November 13<sup>th</sup> and the Christmas Caroling will be November 27.

John Brown said that the warentee on the dock has run out and will need to be repaired.

Discussion of gardening plan: Motion to let Tom O'hare go out for bid to start the gardens of Topinabee in the Spring and maintain during the Summer and Fall made by Dennis Dombroski and seconded by Rachel Osborn. Motion passed.

Bill Morgan brought attention to a leaking roof on the townhall. Dennis Dombroski will take care of the contracting.

Bill Morgan presented an estimate to bring So Extension Road from Numbers North 1332 feet up to specifications for that road in order to get the snowplowing done for next winter. Bill will talk to Burt Township Supervisor Koviak regarding the funding of approximately 48,000.00.

Motion to pay the bills by John Brown and seconded by Dennis Dombroski. Motion passed.
