

MULLETT TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES PROPOSED MEETING MINUTES  
JUNE 7, 2016 – EAST MULLETT TOWN HALL

The Mullett Township Board of Trustees met at the East Mullett Town Hall in Mullett Township, Indian River, Michigan 49749. All Board Members were present: Mary Anne Gale, Rachel Osborn, Kathy Flory, Dennis Dombroski and John Brown.

The Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m., with the recitation of the Pledge of allegiance.

Public Comment was opened at 7:01 p.m.: Joyce Stroman expressed concern about the weeds in the Topinabee Public Library flower garden and also that she is running for Mullett Township Treasurer; Hobart Kirsch introduced himself and informed the public he would be running for supervisor of Mullett Township; Mary O'Hare invited the public as well as those running for office to attend the Topinabee Development Association Annual Meeting on June 25, 10:00 a.m., at the Mullett Township Hall in Topinabee. Tom O'Hare spoke in favor of the North Parking Lot improvement; Erv Crawford inquired about the Boy Scout dock and when it would be installed;

Public Comment was closed at 7:20 p.m.

John Brown made a motion to approve the minutes for May 10, 2016 with a correction by Dennis Dombroski "to monitor out of township calls which first responders make and the township (Mullett) pays for; the township supports the good samaritan calls however, we cannot pay unless it is a Mutual Aid Call requested; seconded by Dennis Dembroski, motion passed.

East Mullett Fire Department reported five EMS calls and two training sessions, A letter was presented to the board by Richard Kauffman and was read explaining the EMS calls which were questioned last month as being “paid calls out of township”. Mr. Kauffman explained in the letter that he had not been paid for “out of township” calls and had responded because CHLS had requested his assistance. He expressed the desire for the board to do more research regarding complaints in the future.

Topinabee Fire Department reported 12 runs and six EMS runs, performed hose testing, parade detail, and training session.

Dennis Dombroski motioned to pass the RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MULLETT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE INSURANCE WITHHOLDING PROGRAM PURSUANT TO PA 495 OF 1980, AS AMENDED with a support vote by Kathy Flory, on a roll call vote as follows:

The supervisor declared the RESOLUTION adopted by the board members present.

Hobart Kirsch reported he had talked to a service company which would be placing a quote for cleaning up the Old School House; however he will need to make an opening in the ceiling to accomplish the cleaning project. Also, will need some storage space to store artifacts until the cleaning project is

completed.. He will bring updated information to the board at the July meeting. A suggestion was made that Bill Morgan may be able to identify the artifacts that will need to be kept for future display

Motion by Dennis Dombroski to rent a temporary storage unit to store the artifacts from the old museum until the Old School House is cleaned up, seconded by John Brown, motion passed.

Motion by Rachel Osborn to go forward with the North Parking Lot Project in Topinabee with support from the community as follows: Topinabee Development; Paul and Debbie Chapoton: Claudia Holland: Tom and Mary O'Hare, Ken Hoehn: Mike O'Hare: Emily E. Matheny: with a second by Dennis Dombroski, motion passed.

John Brown reported the "Off Premise Signs" ordinance will be revised at the Cheboygan County Planning and Zoning for the Topinabee Village Center. Mullett Township will monitor.

Mary Anne Gale will be starting a process to investigate the possibility of Mullett Township taking over the following road ends: Woodruff, Jewell, and Devereaux Lake.

Burt Mullett Cemetery will install a new gate and the annual participation fee to the Burt- Mullett Cemetery will be the same as last year: \$7,100.00 from Mullett Township General Fund.

Hobart Kirsch to investigate replacing the ceiling tiles in the Mullett Township Hall in Topinabee, will report next month July 5, meeting.

John Brown brought up the fact that the flag pole at the East Mullett Hall is still needing repair. Rachel will follow up with Swartz Boiler to see how soon they can complete the work.

There will be an Election Commission Meeting at 6:45 p.m., to appoint the election inspectors for the August 2, 2016 primary, to approve the ballott, to appoint someone to the Public Accuracy Testing procedure.

Dennis Dombroski motioned to pay the bills, seconded by John Brown with a provision that Mary Anne speak to Cottage Care about the fact that Boy Scout Park wasn't ready for the three day weekend (Memorial Day). Motion passed.
