

MULLETT TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES PROPOSED MINUTES
NOVEMBER 1, 2016 – 7:00PM – TOPINABEE, MICHIGAN

The Mullett Township Board of Trustees met at the Mullett Township Hall at 7:00 p.m., in Topinabee, Michigan on November 1, 2016. The following Board Members were present: Mary Anne Gale Rachel Osborn, Dennis Dombroski and John Brown. Kathy Flory was excused.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m., and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all in attendance.

Mary Anne Gale offered a comment about all the good work David Ogg had done for Mullett Township and his passing on October 29, 2016. All in attendance observed a moment of silence in his memory.

Public Comment was opened at 7:01 p.m. Hobart Kirsch asked if the Newsletter could be published in an other venue other than just putting a copy in the tax bills? Those persons who have mortgages would not receive the bills since the taxes are paid by a financial institution. It was decided the board could put the Newsletter on the bulletin board and the Mullett Township Website.

The Minutes of the October 4, 2016 meeting were approved with the following correction: "afton stone instead of gravel" for shoulder dressing. John Brown offered the motion which was seconded by Dennis Dombroski and the motion was passed.

East Mullett Fire Department reported 3 medical runs. Suggest we look at Hometown Angel program at the December meeting since Richard Kauffman could not be here this month.

Topinabee Fire Department reported 8 runs of which six were medical and two were vehicle accidents.

There was a discussion of the Newsletter for Mullett Township with a few corrections and additions. This newsletter will be mailed with the December tax bills.

Dennis Dombroski made a motion to hire Mackinaw Environmental Testing to test any hazardous material that might exist in the Old School House, seconded by John Brown, motion passed.

By consensus: the board decided to take a look at a forthcoming contract from the Longpoint Property Owners Association for signage, bench and maintenance for a historical marker to show where a train depot once was used by the North Central Railroad.

Mary Anne Gale brought a letter from the State of Michigan Treasury Department stating the Mullett Township Board of Review had passed the AMAR with a perfect score.
