

MULLETT TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING MINUTES FOR
APRIL 9, 2019 – 7:00PM – EAST MULLETT TOWNSHIP HALL – INDIAN
RIVER, MICHIGAN

The Mullett Township Board of Trustees meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the East Mullett Town Hall in Indian River, Michigan 49749. The following Board Members were present: Hobart Kirsch, Rachel Osborn, John Brown and Dennis Dombroski. Kathy Flory is excused.

Call to order was at 7:00 p.m. with the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comment was opened at 7:01 p.m. and closed at 7:02 p.m.

John Brown motioned to approve the minutes of the March 5, 2019 meeting and Budget Hearing with a second by Dennis Dombroski, motion carried.

Topinabee Fire Department reported a total number of incidents at 38 with 21 medical assists and 11 training sessions.

East Mullett Fire Department reported 8 medical assists with an assist for a power down line and also an unintentional smoke detector activation.

Catherine Schultz of the "Mullett to Mackinaw" Trail spoke of the drive to get a Trail Town grant from the Pure Michigan Trail Towns program. It would be a way to promote our area including the Topinabee and Cheboygan area. This particular trail would run from the Southern end of Mullett Township to the West end of Machinaw Township. Mullett Township will consider a letter of support for this initiative at the May 7, 2019 regular township meeting.

Discussion of the need for a new swim dock for Boy Scout Park and also a ramp to accommodate same. Hobie Kirsch will be contacting our supplier and getting quotes for the May meeting.

John Brown will be looking at the small trail which would go West from the pavilion as a walking trail with our supplier to get an idea of costs for this project which will be discussed at the May meeting.

Rachel Osborn will be purchasing several fire rings for Boy Scout park and also the paint for the East Mullett Town Hall. Also will be getting quotes for 75 bullards treated to discuss at the May meeting.

Motion offered by John Brown and seconded by Rachel Osborn to pay the bills, with one opposing, motion carried.
