

MULLETT TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING
FOR JANUARY 7, 2020
MULLETT TOWNSHIP HALL – TOPINABEE, MICHIGAN, 7:00 PM

The Mullett Township Board of Trustees met at the Mullett Township Hall in Topinabee, Michigan, on January 7, 2020, at 7:00 pm. Members present were Hobart Kirsch, Rachel Osborn, Kathy Flory, Dennis Dombroski, and John Brown.

The meeting was called to order at 7:04 pm with the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comment was opened at 7:05 pm and closed at 7:27 pm.

Dennis Dombroski moved that the Board approve the minutes of the December 3, 2019 meeting with a second by John Brown. Motion passed.

Topinabee Fire Department reported the following for 2019: 169 runs which consisted of 111 EMS (66%), 16 Accidents (9%), Gas Leaks/Power Lines 15 (9%) and Nuisance Alarms 14 (8%). The location of the runs were as follows: Mullett Township 109 (64%), Burt Township 50 (30%), and Mutual Aid 10 (6%).

The Topinabee Fire Committee reported a positive meeting with their Burt Township counterparts and encouraging reports from financing sources. They anticipate having more information at the next meeting.

Supervisor Kirsch reported that Dollar General had indicated an interest in opening a store in Mullett Township. The Board indicated more information would be needed on a site location before any discussion could ensue.

Rachel Osborn made a motion that approval be given to paint the Hall restrooms with a second by John Brown. Motion passed.

Assistant Librarian Laura LaHaie reported that Windows 10 was successfully installed on all the Library's public computers. She also reported three community programs being offered currently at the Library: Children's Story Hour on Tuesdays at 10:30 am; Craft Club on Thursdays at 1:00 pm; and Genealogy Workshop on Saturday, 11:00 am - 2:00 pm. She's had 68 people participating.

Rachel Osborn presented preliminary plans for a possible use of the Old School House for the Board's review. She also fielded questions from the public in attendance.

Rachel Osborn and Hobie Kirsch read 18 emails received by the Board.

Dennis Dombroski made a motion to pay the bills, which was seconded by John Brown. The motion passed.

John Brown made a motion to adjourn at 8:25 pm, which was seconded by Kathy Flory. The motion passed.
