

SPECIAL MULLETT TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING  
FOR APRIL 21, 2020  
TOPINABEE BEACH PAVILION – TOPINABEE, MICHIGAN, 6:00 PM

The Mullett Township Board of Trustees met at the Topinabee Beach Pavilion in Topinabee, Michigan, on April 21, 2020, at 6:00 PM. Members present were Hobart Kirsch, Rachel Osborn, Kathy Flory, Dennis Dombroski and John Brown. Social distancing was practiced as ordered by the Governor of Michigan.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. with the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comment was opened at 6:01 p.m. with Patty King, Library Director, requesting direction about requests for the rental of Township facilities in the month of May and beyond in light of the Governor's stay-at-home order. After discussion, a motion was made by Rachel Osborn, with support by Dennis Dombroski, to assume cancellation of any rental of township facilities, including the Mullett Township Hall and East Mullett Hall, through June 1<sup>st</sup> until the Governor lifts the order. The motion passed. Mrs. King was directed to notify those that had made inquiries.

Public Comment was closed at 6:09 p.m.

The purpose of the Special Meeting was to discuss the Topinabee Beach Public Restrooms. The pros and cons of having the restrooms remain open were discussed. A motion was made by Dennis Dombroski, with support by Hobart Kirsch, that the restrooms remain open. The motion failed to pass. By consensus of the Board the restrooms will be closed Wednesday, April 22, at 5:00 p.m. and will remain closed until the Board votes to reopen them.

The Board also discussed how to proceed with the May 5, 2020, monthly meeting. Supervisor Kirsch is going to explore options of either a remote Zoom meeting or an outdoor meeting at Schoolhouse Park.

Dennis Dombroski made a motion to adjourn, with support by John Brown. The motion passed.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:45 pm.
