

MULLETT TOWNSHIP ANNUAL MEETING OF THE ELECTORS  
MARCH 1, 2021  
VIA ZOOM AT 6:30 PM

The Mullett Township Annual Meeting of the Electors met remotely via Zoom due to the Public Health Department's order limiting public gatherings.

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 pm with the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance led by Mullett Township Supervisor Laz Surabian.

Electors present were Laz Surabian, Denise Ackerman, Brenda Bowes, Mike Goerke, Brett Lindgren, Howard Gandelot, Lori Hoehn, James Hilyard, and Zoom Moderator Ken Hoehn.

Public Comment was opened at 6:36 pm. There were no public comments.

A motion was made by Mike Goerke, with a second by Brett Lindgren, that the reading of the minutes from the last Annual Meeting of the Electors having been held prior to 1988, be waived. By voice vote the motion passed.

Supervisor Laz Surabian outlined the significant powers designated by state law to electors at the annual meeting:

- 1) All Electors may vote to alter or accept the recommendation of the township board as presented in salary resolutions for each office passed by the township board 30 days prior to the Annual Meeting. (MCL 168.358)
- 2) In a general law township with a population of 5000 or more, or having 3000 registered voters, may expand the size of the board to four trustees. Mullett Township has a population and registered voters of less than those thresholds. (MCL 41.95)

All salaries in Mullett Township have remained the same from the last fiscal year so no vote was necessary.

Public comment was again offered and there was none.

Motion to adjourn was offered by Brett Lindgren, with support from Brenda Bowes, at 6:42 pm. The motion passed.
