MULLETT TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES
MEETING FOR APRIL 11, 2022
6:30 PM AT MULLETT TOWNSHIP HALL

The Mullett Township Board of Trustees met at the Mullett Township Hall in Topinabee, MI, 49791 at 6:30 PM on April 11, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 6:32 PM with a moment of silence to remember Bill Morgan, former Supervisor, Trustee and Fire Chief for Mullett Township, as he passed away that afternoon. Township flags will be flown at half-staff until his funeral to honor his service to the community. The recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance followed. Members present were Supervisor Laz Surabian, Clerk Denise Ackerman, Treasurer Brenda Bowes, Trustee Brett Lindgren, and Trustee Mike Goerke.

Public Comment was opened at 6:33 PM and closed at 6:33 PM with no comments.

Brett Lindgren made a motion, with support by Mike Goerke, that the agenda be approved with one addition to New Business. The motion passed.

Mike Goerke made a motion, with support by Brenda Bowes, that the minutes of the March 14, 2022 meeting be approved. The motion passed.

Brett Lindgren made a motion, with support by Brenda Bowes, that we pay the bills. The motion passed.

A motion was made by Brenda Bowes, with support by Brett Lindgren, that the report be accepted and filed.

The Treasurer reported to the Clerk that all accounts were balanced for the month of March.

Topinabee Fire Chief Mike English made the monthly Fire Report, reporting 10 runs (3 EMS and 7 Fire) for March; 5 in Mullett Township, 1 in Burt Township and 4 for mutual aid.

East Mullett Fire Department reported of 3 Fire runs for March.

Mike Goerke made a motion, with support from Brett Lindgren, that the Board accept the proposals from B-A-S Security Systems for Burglar/Fire Alarm Control for both the Library and the Townhall with a cost of \$995 for installation for each and a monthly monitoring and maintenance fee of \$75. The motion passed.

Judy Jacalone reported that the library will re-open Wednesday, April 13, 2022 at 10 AM with the Grand Reopening scheduled for Sunday, May 29, 2022.

OLD BUSINESS:

- No bids were received for the Woodruff Launch and Dry Hydrant Project in the latest bid request. The bid will be re-written without the dry hydrant and other specifications changed and put back out for bid. The Supervisor will coordinate with Wade Trim.

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- **Adoption of Mullett Township Ordinance No. 2022-01 Repealing Blight Elimination Ordinance No. 2020-01:** Moved by Mike Goerke, seconded by Brenda Bowes. Adopted by Roll Call vote: Yeas: Laz Surabian, Denise Ackerman, Brenda Bowes, Brett Lindgren and Mike Goerke. There were no nays and none absent. Ordinance was declared adopted by Supervisor, Laz Surabian.
- A motion was made by Mike Goerke, with support from Brenda Bowes, to adopt a Blight Complaint Flow Chart outlining the procedural steps to be taken before a blight complaint is forwarded to the County Sheriff. The Board named Mike Goerke, Trustee, as the primary contact with the Sheriff's Department and also the primary blight inspector, with assistance as necessary from Brett Lindgren and Laz Surabian. The motion passed.
- A proposal from Rieth-Riley for asphaltting the Townhall parking lot was tabled until the price can be verified as still viable.

CURRENT BUSINESS

- The request from Cheboygan Farmers' Market to place a sign at Topinabee Park was tabled for further research.
- A request from a resident for swim buoys at Layman's Landing at the end of Devereaux Lake Road was tabled for additional research with the DNR and Road Commission.
- A request for a Contractors' Work Order System was tabled for further consideration.

Call to the Public was called at 9:47PM with one comment.

Motion to adjourn was offered by Brett Lindgren, with support by Brenda Bowes, at 9:49 PM. The motion passed.
