

MULLETT TOWNSHIP TOWNHALL MEETING FOR JULY 25, 2022
6:30 PM AT MULLETT TOWNSHIP HALL

The Mullett Township Board of Trustees met at the Mullett Township Hall in Topinabee, MI, 49791 at 6:30 PM on July 25, 2022 for the third annual Townhall Meeting.

The meeting was called to order at 6:33 PM with the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Board members present were Supervisor Laz Surabian, Clerk Denise Ackerman, Treasurer Brenda Bowes, Trustee Mike Goerke, and Trustee Brett Lindgren.

The meeting was opened with remarks from Supervisor Laz Surabian explaining that this was a meeting for the Board to hear the concerns, questions, and comments of the public. Supervisor Surabian began with a summary of the accomplishments of the Board in the last year. He then opened the floor for public comment at 6:52 PM. The following issues were addressed:

- Problem with flooding in garages on Woodruff Street and blockage of drains with debris
- Concerns voiced with bringing the Burt-Mullett Trail down Woodruff Street
- Concerns voiced about the speed limits through town on M27, especially around the Woodruff Launch as boat trailers are parked along the road and the need for crosswalk signs in the downtown area
- The dock at the Woodruff Boat Launch is too high for fishing boats
- Concerns voiced about needing a Fireworks/Noise Ordinance, perhaps county-wide so it could be enforced
- Problem with invasive species overgrowth covering speed signs and the best way to control it
- Traffic control effort on Topinabee Mail Route Rd has been helpful. Please continue the efforts
- Concern was voiced about the condition of the Sutherland Steps
- Elaine Thompson voiced concern about a blight complaint issued on her property. Her statement is attached to these minutes.
