MULLETT TOWNSHIP TOWNHALL MEETING FOR JULY 31, 2023 6:30 PM AT MULLETT TOWNSHIP HALL

The Mullett Township Board of Trustees met at the Mullett Township Hall in Topinabee, MI, 49791 at 6:30 PM on July 31, 2023, for the fourth annual Townhall Meeting.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM with the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Board members present were Supervisor Laz Surabian, Clerk Denise Ackerman, Treasurer Brenda Bowes, and Trustee Mike Goerke.

The meeting was opened with remarks from Supervisor Laz Surabian explaining that this was a meeting for the Board to hear the concerns, questions, and comments of the public. He opened the floor for public comment.

Lori Hoehn graciously opened with a summary of the accomplishments of the Board in the last year and voiced her thanks to the Board.

The following issues were addressed:

- Portage Road needs attention.
- There is a safety issue with overgrowth at the intersections of many roads -- Portage and Phelps were noted.
- Golf carts and Side by Sides are a safety issue on Straits Highway and are being cited by the sheriff.
- The public restrooms have been extremely dirty and unsanitary and need more attention, especially in the summer.
- A five-year plan would be helpful for the future management of Township funds. Where is the Street Scape Plan at?
- The safety and maintenance of the Woodruff Launch is an ongoing concern.
- Schoolhouse Park needs tree trimming and maintenance of the ballfield.
- There is a hole in the back of the old Schoolhouse that needs fixing.

Motion was made to adjourn at 7:30 PM by Ken Hoehn and supported by Margaret Widrig. The meeting was adjourned by Supervisor Surabian who offered thanks from the Board for the public's input and suggestions.
