

## Mullett Township Minutes from the February 12th meeting.

Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Laz Surabian.

Supervisor, Laz Surabian, Treasurer, Brenda Bowes, Trustees, Mike Goerke and Brett Lindgren and Deputy Clerk, Joyce Stroman were in attendance.

A motion was made by Brett Lindgren to pay the bills, seconded by Mike Goerke. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Brett Lindgren to accept the Treasurer report, seconded by Mike Goerke. Motion Carried. We were at 81% and the budget was balanced for the last 39 months. All of the reports were read from the Treasurer, Clerk, Mike English- the fire chief, The Burt Lake trail, Cemetery report and Library report from Judy Jackalone. She also introduced her new assistant Andrew Newman.

A motion was made by Brett Lindgren for Chief Mike English to have a \$1,500 admin fee for the East Mullett Lake Fire Department, Seconded by Laz Surabian. Motion carried.

Updates were given on the Woodruff Launch-Brett Lindgren, The Boyscout Park, (a great update from Mike Goerke on the Grant process), Blight-Mike Goerke and Hall Rental-Laz Surabian. The Hall rental policy will be addressed again next month. The Hall has a 150 person capacity.

A motion was made by Brenda Bowes and seconded by Brett Lindgren to have a small Free Library stand installed at the Boyscout Park. Motion carried.

Mike Goerke made a motion to hire a part time maintenance person, seconded by Brenda Bowes. Motion carried.

Board of Review items were discussed. We have to be AMAR qualified.

More Public comment. Andrea Newman wanted to know when there was going to be more updates on this side of the lake at both parks.

No board comments and the meeting adjourned at 8:30.
